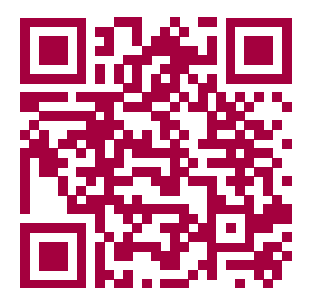
MSRI-NCTS joint summer school Recent Topic in Well Posedness

Date: 18-29 Jul, 2022 Venue: NCTS/Hawaii

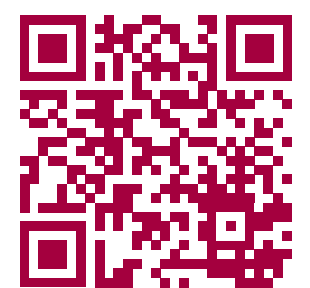
The National Center of Theoretical Sciences (NCTS) Mathematics Division is pleased to call for applications for students who are enrolled full-time at a university or a research institution in Taiwan to attend the 2022 Summer Graduate School “Recent Topics in Well Posedness” sponsored by NCTS and MSRI. The purpose of the workshop is to introduce students to fundamental results on the Navier-Stokes and the Euler equations, with special emphasis on the solvability of its initial value problem with rough initial data as well as the large time behavior of a solution. This summer school is scheduled from July 18, 2022 to July 29, 2022. The Venue will most likely be in Hawaii (not totally finalized yet). Nominations of summer school attendees by the NCTS will receive full local support and travel support.
